

Layout of the full text (only electronic versions are accepted)

Paper/Poster Title 14pt bold, capital letters, centered

Name and surname of all Authors 1 - 12pt normal, centered

1 Complete mailing address of the corresponding author - *12pt italic, centered*

Key words: *11pt Italic*

Abstract: This short section provides all necessary information and instructions for the author(s). Abstract is required to have maximum 12 rows, 11pt bold/normal.

I. Introduction (Section Title - 12pt bold)

The submitted contributions will be published on the CD-ROM as Proceedings of the 43rd IPC, thus without any editorial changes and corrections. Therefore, the authors should make every effort to prepare their papers in a proper form. (Body Text - 12pt normal).

II. Paper Layout

The full-text must have preferably not more than 15 pages, including all figures, illustrations, tables and references. Use margins: top and bottom 2,54 cm (1 inch), left and right 3,17 cm (1,25 inches). The recommended font type is Arial or similar. Make sure, that all labels and text information contained in the figures is at least 10 points in font size. **Do not number the pages and do not put any information in Header or Footer. Do not use business letterhead.**

We accept only electronic submission of the contributions as MSWord or PDF files. In the case of any problem, please contact the conference organizers.

Each table, diagram, illustration or figure should have corresponding number, title and reference to the text. Similarly to figures, tables should be positioned on an appropriate place in the text. The recommended font size is 12pt. For large text the minimum text size of 10pt can be used. The tables should be numbered consecutively in roman numbers.

Mathematical Formulae

Mathematical formulae should be centered on line and numbered consecutively on the right margin, as shown in the example below:

$$E_{kin} = \frac{1}{2}mv^2$$

Titles of Main Passages

They are typed in capital letters, bold from the beginning of the left margin. All the titles are separated from the previous text by one blank row except for the first passage separated from the title two blank rows.

Passage titles of the second order

They are typed in bold, small letters from the beginning of the left margin. Passage titles longer than one row should be avoided.

References

Only the title directly connected to the paper topic should be given. At the end of the paper the literature is given as follows:

[1] Author 1, Author 2,... *Title of a Book*, Publisher, Year.

[2] Author 1, Author 2,... "Title of a Paper Published in a Journal," *Journal Title*, Vol. #, No. #, pp. #-#, year.

[3] Author 1, Author 2,... "Title of a Paper Published in Proceedings of a Conference," *Proceedings of what Conference*, Year, City, Country, pp. #-#.
